The regular Kindergarten schedule starts on Thursday, August 23. When you drop off your child, you can use the west doors at the front/back of the school, or you can come through the gate on the west end of the school and walk them to the classroom door. Parents should say any "good-byes" there. This helps the child develop independence and an understanding that school is their "job" and classroom duties are their own responsibilities. We want to foster independence and an "I Can Do It" attitude.

At the end of the day, we will walk all the students out the west end doors and to the fence by the parking lot. Kindergarten students will be required to wait by the fence until a parent or older sibling picks them up. For safety reasons it's appreciated that students be picked up on time.
