Second Grade Reading Program

Dear Parents,

To encourage reading for the second half of the year, the second grade will be participating in an **“Ice Cream” Reading Program**. The first week of each month your child needs to choose a chapter book to read. Please help your child choose a book appropriate for his or her reading level (You need to do the “five finger test” to make sure the book is appropriate).

Students need to write the title of their book on the paper which is in the homework folder by the Friday of the first week of each month! There will also be a book report summary paper in the homework folder that will need to be filled out about the book before they can present their project.

Before the last day of each month (January through April), your child must have finished reading the book, filled out the book report, and have a project made to share with the class. I have attached a list of project ideas that can be used. **Please save this paper!** Projects need to be different for each book. We will be sharing them the last week of each month.

Those students who read a chapter book and complete a project each month (4 in all), will be able to participate in our **Ice Cream Party in May**. There will be no exceptions. Please encourage your child to read at least 20 minutes each night. If your child finishes the chapter book before the month is over, keep reading other books for the remainder of the month. Make sure to keep track of the days on your child’s monthly reading calendar.
