Welcome to 6th grade! I am excited to have the opportunity to work with you and get to know you. This coming year promises to be great with the many exciting lessons and activities. This letter is just to let you know about some basic and important information for our upcoming year together.

In 6th grade, it will be very important for your student to stay current in each of his/her subjects. Progress reports will come home monthly and will indicate missing assignments and show how well your child is doing. Please carefully look over these and encourage or praise your child as needed.

You can also check your student's grades online whenever you would like. Just go to the classroom webpage and there is a link that will guide you through this process. You will need to know your student's lunch number and birthdate.

To celebrate students that are 100% current with their assignments, we will be taking several field trips throughout the 6th grade year. **ONLY** students that are 100% with their work will be allowed to go. **Students that are missing assignments will be required to be at school and will work with one of the teachers that will stay behind.**

Parents, each day a **homework planner** will be coming home with assignments for the following day. Please take a few minutes each day to review the homework. Help your student if necessary and sign the assignment sheet. The homework folder then needs to be returned the following school day. This will help us know how well your student is doing with assignments, keep your student up to date, and emphasize student responsibility to further prepare your student for seventh grade.

Please also bring the following supplies by of the 1st week of school:

- 1- Three-ring 2" binder (to hold folders, paper, assignments, etc.)
- 2- 7 folders with pockets that can be placed in binder (without metal brads)
- 3- Colored pencils & markers (optional)
- 4- Large boxes of tissues (the more we have, the better!)
- 5- Glue sticks
- 6- Blue or Black pen
