LAKEVIEW ELEMENTARY 4th Grade



READING: This year we will be studying a variety of basic reading skills and will be placing a

special emphasis on literature. I encourage your student to read aloud or silently at least 20 min. each night at home as it will help improve comprehension and oral fluency. Your child needs to have a free reading book at his/her desk every day!!

SPELLING: Every day we will go through the Morphographic Spelling workbook. Morphographs

are prefixes, suffixes, bases and roots of words. Your child will learn spelling rules

and their applications. We have found this program to be very beneficial in

improving the students' spelling skills.

MATH: It will be critical that your fourth grader knows basic multiplication and division

facts. Flashcards, games, etc. can reinforce these skills at home. Any extra time you can spend at home with tough concepts (long division, decimals, fractions, time, money, etc.) will be helpful! We will also be practicing these skills during our

computer time.

UTAH HISTORY: Our social studies text is *The Utah Adventure*. We will study pioneers, mountain

men, Native Indians, and counties. We will have several hands-on activities through

the year.

SCIENCE: Rotation to other fourth grade teachers will take place at four-week intervals. We

will be studying Utah plants, animal and land formations, weather, the water

cycle, fossils, and rocks and minerals.

WRITING: Students will be participating in the writing process-- brainstorming, drafting,

revising, editing and publishing their writing. They will also be working with a variety of writing formats throughout the year, for example, poetry, letters,

creative writing, etc.

MUSIC: The students will be taught by a music specialist each week. We will perform a

Christmas concert and perform a play in the spring.
