What do we do with this data as a school?

- Data Dives with each grade-level. One full day going through each grade's data and writing an action plan for how to improve within our sphere of influence. We have done the Data Dives for five grades and have Kindergarten and 6th Grade left.

- What can we learn from the comparisons with other like schools?

Could we go visit other schools like Orchard, Orem, etc.?

- How can we help our subgroups of Students with Disabilities and English Learners?

- Why is Acadience higher than the district but RISE is lower? It takes times for change to show up on RISE. It only looks at grades 3-6. It's a good question... we aren't sure why. It is good that 90% of 6th graders leave Lakeview reading at benchmark or above.

- How does the Panorama Climate Survey work? What do we do with that data? The social worker administers the test to every class for grades 4-6.

We look at school wide data and set goals and action plans. For students with very low scores who cannot identify a single strength that they have, our social worker meets with each student's families to talk about it. Can parents see their own students' scores? Not right now.

How can we increase parental involvement?

- Amanda - Talking Points app - allows for two-way communication in multiple languages

- David - in interviewing Hispanic parents in the past on SCC, many don't know how to get more engaged at the school
