Follow-Up:

We are having a lot of money taken away from the school from the district which has good and negative impact, we will lose a lot of aides. Last month, we talked about not using these funds for aides, but with new information we may need Trustlands help for some of our aides needs. That is included in the proposal for that reason.

Council will weigh in on TSSA money as well as Trustlands money. District is paying for an instructional coach so that will free up that money.

Prepare School Land Trust Plan for 24/25 School Year

Goal #1 Increase math proficiency schoolwide

- Refer to Rise data dive numbers by grade level
- 50% of students or above proficient on Acadience Math at end of school year.
- Upper grades maintain, lower grades need help
- Financial needs-3 math aides for 30 minute math segments per grade level per day, would prefer 4 aides. *Would creating a volunteer pool be helpful, using a paid aide to organize and train? We could use volunteers in kindergarten and Portuguese, less in literacy or math because of the level of training and*

consistency that needs to be maintained. Volunteers could be older retired couples or young with no children. Post covid has been more difficult to get volunteers.

- Goal will need an action plan-currently beginning with moving some teachers around to distribute strong leaders in every grade level.
- Support Acadience goals and team collaboration-a need would be substitutes for teachers to collaborate and have time to focus on testing students etc.

Goal #2 Increase ELA proficiency and growth schoolwide

- State ELA goal is 60% for Acadience Reading
- Refer to Lakeview numbers
- Lakeview goal is 80% growth
- We have had a roller coaster of high scores/low scores, we would like to see consistency in all grades- teacher changes have been made for next year to address inconsistencies.
- The state pays for all testing and materials.

Goal #3 SIP -Climate goal

- Panorama Surveys used to get an idea of student climate.
- More implementation of Second Step program in the classrooms.
- Office referrals have increased -new teachers and younger grade teachers account for the majority of the numbers. Hard mix of kids. Newer teachers will not be assigned to younger grades.
- Wellness room visits have increased which is good, they only get 10 minutes in the room. Room is being used to help with the office referral students as part of their behavior plan.

Goal #4 Special Ed goal

Additional Discussion:

Timeline on Trustlands plan-due to the state in May, but it has to be approved by district and then school board, so it needs to be approved by the council in March. Council will need to vote on the plan at the March meeting.

Results of Survey Sent By District To Students, Parents, Employees by level of importance:

- 1-mental health of students, employees
- 2-math and reading proficiencies
- 3- ensuring opportunities for all student levels
- 4- high school readiness
- 5- school safety
