 - Looked at needs assessment and data from previous year.
 - Discussed specific Academic goals :
 - Math Every grade level K-6 will have 50% of students proficient or above on the Acadience Math (or NWEA). Every grade level 3-6 will have 50% proficient or above on RISE math.
 - **ELA** Every grade level K-6 will have 70% of students proficient or above and 80% of students making typical or above growth on Acadience Reading. Every grade level will have 50% of students proficient or above on RISE English language arts.
 - Discussed reasoning for proficiency vs growth goals for our school.
- Jamie gave a summary of expenditures under the School Community Council's disgression. (Council will vote on Trustland money, as well as weigh in on TSSA money.)
